## **Proposed Spring 2010 Flyaway Itinerary**

### **Day 0- Saturday September 4 -Broken Hill (YBHI)**

Accommodation at Mine Host Motel (08 8088 4044)  
Mine Host Motel is centrally located in Argent St, the CBD main street.  
Evening Dinner at Motel

### **Day 1 – Sunday September 5 - Broken Hill to Rawnsley Park (YRYK)**

Breakfast at Motel  
Tour of Broken Hill will be arranged for 0900 to 1100hrs and drop off at Airport for departure at 1145hrs  
Rawnsley Park is situated in the Flinders Ranges and adjacent to Wilpena Pound. Accommodation at Rawnsley Park Station, Wilpena Pound SA  
Explore Wilpena Pound and the Flinders Ranges from the air or on a ground tour  
Lunch on arrival and Dinner at the Rawnsley Park Chalet/Homestead/ Resort

### **Day 2 Monday September 6: Rawnsley Park to Olympic Dam (YOLD)**

Breakfast at Chalet/Homestead/Resort  
Depart from 1000hrs. An opportunity to fly the Flinders Ranges, Wilpena Pound and surrounding areas.  
Accommodation: 15 Rooms at the Roxby Downs Motor Inn

### **Day 3 – Tuesday September 7- Roxby Downs to Marree (YMRE)**

Breakfast at Motel  
0900hrs- Coach pick up at Motel for a 3.5 hr Surface Tour of Olympic Dam Mine with official BHP-Billiton Tour Guide Deb Ainsleigh  
1400hr departure for Marree  
Famous Outback town.  
Overnight Marree. Accommodation: Marree Hotel/Motel  
Host is Laurie Kalms. If time available we can try and book a local Aboriginal Reg Dodd who can take us to Lake Eyre for an insight into local Aboriginal Lore and Culture. Apparently a very interesting man. “Marree Man” has all but disappeared.  
Dinner at Marree Hotel/Motel

### **Day 4 – Wednesday September 8 Marree to William Creek (YWMC) to Coober Pedy (YCPB)**

Breakfast at Hotel/Motel  
Departure. No later than 1100hrs  
Select own route to William Creek but in order to see something of what Lake Eyre has to offer, suggest fly overhead Muloorina Station, north of Marree continue to mid east coast of Lake Eyre then fly west to William Creek for a pre-ordered lunch. Find and experience the Anna Creek Painted Hills

Depart after lunch and continue on to Coober Pedy direct or via Painted Hills which may be a little SW of William Creek.( More Detail is being obtained)  
Arrive Coober Pedy no later than 1700hrs.

Accommodation: 15 Double rooms at the Mud Hut Motel. This is an above ground Motel in the center of town.

Explore this World famous Opal Town. If members want the experience of underground overnight stay, it can be arranged but at an extra cost.

I have accepted a quote from Martin Smith of “radekadownunder” Bus Tours in Coober Pedy to pick us up from the airport probably in two trips, take us to the Mud Hut and next morning to take us on a 2.5 hrs Tour of Coober Pedy including a shopping spree, then take us to a convenient place for a pre-ordered lunch then to the airport for a 1500hr departure for Ceduna.

#### **Day 5- Thursday 9 September-Coober Pedy to Ceduna (YCDU)**

Breakfast at Mud Hut Motel or as required

0900hrs- 2.5 hrs Tour of Coober Pedy and lunch.

Depart no later than 1500hrs

Accommodation: 15 rooms at the Best Western Foreshore Hotel/Motel Ceduna for Thursday 9 September.
